Position Title: Bridging the Gap In-class Programming Assistant

Description of Program:

In-class programming is available to help students extend their experience of habitat exploration and to re-investigate terms and concepts that they were introduced to while participating in field trip programs. Activities are geared towards providing learning experiences which share indigenous cultural teachings and encourage stewardship. We currently offer two in-class activities and look forward to further growth and development in this program area. During the gardening season an additional two, in-class programs are offered; seed starting and Three Sisters Gardening.

Volunteer Responsibilities:

Assist with Bridging The Gap's In-class programming. Duties will vary depending on program, requests from schools (please see BridgingTheGap.co -in-class programming for more information on our specific programs). Programs run in various inner city schools during November through June yearly. A minimum commitment of 10 half days (8:45am-12:15pm or 1:00pm-3:30pm) is required.

- Knowledge or interest in gardening
- Experience working with youth and elders
